ALEX BIRD RULES

- 1. One selection is made in each relevant race for the appropriate day of the meeting. Selections must be for either a named horse or a specific trainer's entry, but you can also nominate 'The Favourite' in races.
- 2a. Points will be scored on the basis of the winner and other placed horses with bonus points based on the odds for the winner only.
- 2b. The points scoring system is (per race) 15pts winner, 10pts second, 5pts third, 2pts fourth (placed horse points will match normal e/w terms). Bonus points will be added for winners only, depending on starting price:

Under 5/1 no bonus points, 5/1 to 10/1 3 bonus points, 11/1 to 15/1 6 bonus points, 16/1 to 20/1 9 bonus points, 22/1 to 28/1 12 bonus points, 30/1 + 18 bonus points.

- 3a. Non-runner, the selection transfers onto the favourite. In the event of joint favourites, the selection is the lowest Race Card number.
- 3b. Dead heats will result in the win/place points being shared equally by the horses concerned with bonus points also halved if the 1st place is a dead heat.
- 4. Entries may include a second selection which will apply if the original choice is a non-runner, otherwise "on the favourite" will operate

5 In the event of no entry being received for a particular day from an entrant who has paid the entry fee, all the favourites will apply for that day with points scored accordingly. However, this rule will only apply to a maximum of 1 day for each of the 4 rounds
