

Easter Saturday – Carlisle Trendsetters Guide

Previous race trends (2014-23) can often help provide a shortlist of potential winners in the current year's races. The favourite's win ratio is shown in brackets after the race details if run at least three times before. Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the five-day declaration stage.

1.55 – 2m 1f (Conditional Jockeys) Handicap Hurdle: Run as a Class 4 race for the first time in 2022. Both winners to date were 4th on their last run (21-23 days earlier) with odds of 11/2 to 8/1 seen.

2.30 – 2m 5f Novices' Handicap Chase (Fav 33%): New race in 2021. All winners to date had finished 5th or better on their last *completed* race. All also carried a weight of 11st 1ls to 11st 3lbs. Lonest priced winner was 11/1.

3.05 – 2m 3f Novices' Hurdle (Fav 33%): New race in 2021. All winners to date were aged 6yo and had finished either 1st or 2nd on their last run. In the betting they all had odds of 3/1 or shorter

3.40 – 2m 4f Handicap Chase: Race restored to Class 3 status with last runnings at this grade being in 2014 & 2015. Both of those winners carried a weight of 11st 7lbs – 11st 8lbs and had last run 36-42 days earlier.

4.15 – 3m 1f Handicap Hurdle: Run as a Class 4 race for the first time in 2023. Trainer to watch: D Whillans (won 2023).

4.50 – 2m Handicap Chase: Being run as a Class 4 race for the first time in 2024.

5.25 – 2m 3f Handicap Hurdle: Race previously restricted to amateur jockeys.
