## NATIONAL HUNT MEETINGS

**New Years Day Cheltenham – 2m 5f Handicap Chase:** N Twiston-Davies has won the race 3 times (in 2015, 18 & 22). All last ran 19-23 days earlier and carried a weight of 11<sup>st</sup> 2lbs or less.

**New Years Day Exeter – 2m 2.5f Maiden Hurdle:** H Fry has won 3 times (in 2020, 22 & 23). All started as favourites and were 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> LTO.

**New Years Day Exeter – 2m 1f Maiden NH Flat:** P Nicholls has won 3 times (in 2015, 23 & 24). All were 5/1 or shorter (two were favourites).

**New Years Day Fairyhouse – 2m 4f Maiden Hurdle:** G Elliott has won 3 times (2017-19). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on either of their last two runs, with odds of 9/2 or shorter seen.

**New Years Day Fairyhouse – 2m 3f (Mares) Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 3 times (in 2019, 20 & 22). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**New Years Day Fairyhouse – 2m 5f+ Beginners Chase:** W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2016, 20, 22, 23 & 24). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**New Years Day Fairyhouse – 2m NH Flat:** G Elliott has won 3 times (in 2015, 23 & 24). All had odds of 13/2 or shorter (two 2<sup>nd</sup> favourites).

**New Years Day Fakenham – 2m 4f Handicap Hurdle:** Mrs L Wadham has won 3 times (in 2015, 17 & 18). All were rested 51-66 days before winning here and had odds of 5/1 or shorter.

**New Years Day Musselburgh – 2m Juvenile Hurdle (4yo):** Irish trainer J C McConnell has won 3 times (in 2019, 20 & 23). All had odds of 7/2 or shorter with just one starting as favourite.

**New Years Day Musselburgh – 2m 4f Handicap Hurdle:** L V Russell has won 3 times (in 2015, 18 & 22). All had odds of 11/2 to 14/1.

**New Years Day Tramore – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2015, 20, 21, 22 & 24). All had odds of 8/1 or shorter.

**New Years Day Tramore – (Gr 3) 'Savills' Chase over 2m 5f:** <u>W P Mullins</u> has won 5 times (in 2018, 19, 20, 21 & 22). All were rested at least 39 days since their last race and were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on their last *completed* race. <u>H De Bromhead</u> now has 3 wins (in 2017, 23 & 24), All were 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> on their last *completed* race. <u>Race Fact:</u> 2019/20/21 winner, *Al Boum Photo,* went on to win the 2019/20 Cheltenham Gold Cup and was placed in the 2021 race..

**Sunday January 2<sup>nd</sup> Ayr – 2m 6f Handicap Hurdle**: Irish trainer S Crawford has won the race 3 times (in 2014, 16 & 18). Two were well supported as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites with the other easier to back at 9/1.

**Thursday January 5<sup>th</sup> Clonmel – 2m 'Mares' Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won for 3 consecutive years (2017-19) & 2022-23. All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Thursday January 5<sup>th</sup> Clonmel – 2m 1f 'Munster' Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2014, 16, 20, 22 & 23). Just two started as favourites with all having odds of 8/1 or shorter. \*Distance reduced from 2m 4f to 2m 1f in 2023.

**Saturday January 7<sup>th</sup> Cork – 2m 4f Beginners Chase:** W P Mullins has won 3 times (in 20013, 15 & 18). All started as favourites.

**Saturday January 7<sup>th</sup> Sandown – 2m Handicap Hurdle:** N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2017, 18 & 20). All were either 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> LTO.

**Sunday January 8<sup>th</sup> Naas – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins/P Townend have won 3 times (in 2020, 22 & 23). All were 3<sup>rd</sup> or better LTO and started as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Sunday January 8<sup>th</sup> Naas – 2m Novices' Chase**: W P Mullins has won 6 times (in 2016, 18, 20, 21, 22 & 23). All had won their last race and had odds of 7/2 or shorter.

Sunday January 8<sup>th</sup> Naas – (Gr 1)\* 'Lawlor's Of Naas' Novices' Hurdle over 2m 4f: Two trainers have a strong record in this race. <u>W P Mullins</u> has won 5 times (in 2014, 15, 16, 18 & 23). Four had also won their last <u>completed</u> race (8-21 days earlier) with 3 of the 5 last running 21 days earlier. \*Race upgraded from Gr 2 to Gr 1 in 2015. <u>G Elliott</u> has also won 4 times (in 2017, 19, 20 & 21). All were favourites and won LTO.

**Thursday Jan 12<sup>th</sup> Catterick – 'North Yorkshire Grand National' over 3m 6f:** Sue Smith has won for 4 consecutive years (2016-19). All were rested at least 19 days before winning and carried a weight between 11<sup>st</sup> 4lbs & 11<sup>st</sup> 12lbs.

**Friday January 10<sup>th</sup> Huntingdon – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2015, 17 & 18). All had odds of 6/1 or shorter and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> LTO.

Friday January 10<sup>th</sup> Huntingdon – 2m 6f (Mares) Maiden Hurdle: N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2013, 15 & 18). All had odds of 4/1 or shorter.

**Friday January 14<sup>th</sup> Sedgefield – 2m 3f Handicap Chase:** B Ellison has won 3 times (in 2019, 20 & 22). All were 4<sup>th</sup> or better LTO with odds of 9/2 or shorter.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – 2m Hurdle (4yo):** G Elliott has won 3 times (in 2018, 19 & 21). All were 3<sup>rd</sup> or better LTO with odds of 4/1 or shorter.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – (Gr A) Handicap Chase over 2m 1f:** G Elliott has won for 3 consecutive years (2017-19). Two were 3/1 favourites with the other a 13/2 shot.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – 2m 1f Beginners Chase:** W P Mullins has won 6 times (in 2015, 16, 18, 20, 22 & 23). Five were sent off as favourites, the other being the stable's 2<sup>nd</sup> string in the race.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – 2m NH Flat Race:** Two trainers have a strong record in this race: <u>W</u> <u>P Mullins</u> has won 4 times (in 2015, 18, 20 & 23). All were ridden by P W Mullins with odds of 9/2 or shorter. <u>G Elliott</u> also has 3 wins (in 2016, 19 & 21). Two were favourites and the other a 4/1 shot.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Kempton – (Gr 2) 'Silviniaco Conti' Chase over 2m 4.5f:** Two trainers have a strong record in this race: <u>N Henderson</u> has won 4 times (in 2016, 17, 19 & 22). Three had finished 3<sup>rd</sup> LTO and the other pulled up in the Gr 1 'King George' Chase here on Boxing Day. <u>P Nicholls</u> now has 3 wins (in 2020, 21 & 23). All were either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Kempton –2m Handicap Hurdle:** N Henderson has won 4 times (in 2014, 18, 20 & 22). Three were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites with odds of 7/2 or shorter and the other an 11/2 shot..

**Saturday January 14<sup>th</sup> Warwick – (Gr 2) Ballymore 'Leamington' Novices' Hurdle over 2m 5f:** D Skelton has won 3 times (in 2015, 19 & 23). All had odds of 9/2 to 6/1 and were either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO.

**Sunday January 15<sup>th</sup> Punchestown – (Gr 2) 'Moscow Flyer' Novices' Hurdle over 2m:** W P Mullins has won 6 times (in 2014, 15, 16, 17, 22 & 23). All had won their last race (30-49 days earlier) and were sent off as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> Of the stable's recent winners three went on to win at Cheltenham (Mikael D'haguenet, Vautour & Douvan) with Min 2nd at the Festival.

**Sunday January 15<sup>th</sup> Punchestown – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** G Elliott has won 3 times (in 2019, 22 & 23). All had odds of 3/1 or shorter and were 4<sup>th</sup> or better on their last <u>completed</u> run.

**Wednesday January 19th Newbury – 2m Novices' Hurdle**: N Henderson has won 4 times (in 2017, 18, 20 & 21). All had odds of 3/1 or shorter, including one favourite, one joint favourite and one 2<sup>nd</sup> favourite.

**Wednesday January 19th Newbury – 2m NH Flat Race**: B Pauling has won 3 times (in 2019, 20 & 21). All had odds of 11/2 or shorter, including two second favourites.

Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Ascot – 2m Juvenile Hurdle (4yo): A King has 3 wins (in 2016, 18 & 21). All started as favourites.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Ascot – 2m 5f Handicap Chase:** P Nicholls has won 3 times (in 2014, 15 & 19). All carried a weight of 11<sup>st</sup> 4lbs or greater.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Ascot – (Gr 1) Clarence House Chase over 2m 1f**: W P Mullins has won the race for 3 consecutive years (2016-18) with *Un De Sceaux* including one race at Cheltenham in 2017, due to weather issues. All three wins were at odds of 2-1 on or shorter. <u>Race Fact:</u> In recent years winners of this race who also won the QM Chase at Cheltenham included *Master Minded (2009), Sprinter Sacre (2013), Sire De Grugy (2014), Dodging Bullets (2015) & Altior (2019). The 2016 winner (<i>Un De Sceaux*) was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the QM Chase, and after winning this race again in 2017, won the Ryanair Chase at the festival. After the third win in 2018, the horse managed 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Ryanair at Cheltenham.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Ascot – 2m 6f Novices' Hurdle:** N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2015, 19 & 20). All were favourites and had finished 4<sup>th</sup> or better LTO.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Haydock – (Gr 2) 'Champion Hurdle Trial' over 2m:** Nigel Twiston-Davies/Sam Twiston-Davies have won for 4 consecutive years (2015-18) with *The New One.* The horse was sent off as favourite each time having finished 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO. *Ballyandy* scored for the same team in 2020.

Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Haydock – (Gr 2) 'Peter Marsh' Handicap Chase over 3m 2f: Mrs S J Smith has won 3 times (in 2016, 19 & 20). All were 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> LTO and carried a weight of 10st 4lbs to 10st 11lbs. In the betting all had odds of 6/1 to 7/1.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Haydock – 2m Handicap Chase:** D McCain has won for 3 consecutive years (2016-18) with *Ubaltique*. Surprisingly, with this record, the horse has never started as favourite even though always 3<sup>rd</sup> or better on its last run with odds of 5/2 to 11/2 seen.

**Saturday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Navan – 2m 4f Maiden Hurdle:** G Elliott has won 3 times (one division in 2021) and both divisions in 2022). Two were favourites and the other an unraced 10/1 shot.

Saturday January 21<sup>st</sup> Navan – 2m NH Flat Race: G Elliott has won 3 times (in 2018, 20 & 21). All had odds of 100/30 or shorter.

**Saturday January 21<sup>st</sup> Taunton – 3m 4f 'Portman Cup' Chase**: P Nicholls/B Frost have won 3 times with *Yala Enki* (in 2020-22). Sent off as favourite each time.

**Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Thurles – (Gr 2) 'Horse & Jockey Hotel' Chase over 2m 4f:** Two trainers have a strong record in this race: <u>G Elliott</u> has won 3 times (in 2015, 16 & 18). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites having finished 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on their last completed race. <u>W P Mullins</u> has also won 3 times (in 2020, 21 & 22). All started as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> Both *Don Cossack (2016) & Sizing John (2017)* won the race before taking the Cheltenham Gold Cup in the same year. *Allaho (2021)* went on to win the Ryanair Chase after winning here.

Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Thurles – (Gr 2) 'Irish EBF Irish Mares ' Novices' Chase over 2m 4f: W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2015, 17, 19, 20, 21 & 23). All won LTO and started as favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> 2015 winner, *Vroum Vroum Mag* went on to win the Gr 1 'Mares Hurdle' at the Cheltenham Festival the following year.

**Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup> Thurles – 2m 7f Novices' Hurdle:** G Elliott has won 4 times (in 2017, 18, 21 & 22). All had won LTO with odds up to 12/1 seen.

**Tuesday January 24<sup>th</sup> Down Royal – 2m NH Flat Race:** G Elliott has won 3 times (in 2017, 19 & 23). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Thursday January 26<sup>th</sup> Wetherby – 2m Novices' Hurdle:** D Skelton has won 3 times (in 2018, 22 & 23). All were either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO and were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites when winning here.

**Thursday January 26<sup>th</sup> Gowran Park – (Gr 'A') Thyestes Handicap Chase over 3m 1f:** W P Mullins has won 5\* times (in 2014, 15, 19, 20 & 23). All last raced 23-54 days earlier. The trainer often has multiple runners in the race. <u>Race Fact:</u> Many winners of the race have gone on to run in the Aintree Grand National and whilst winners running in the same year have not fared well two past winners, *Hedgehunter (2004) & Numbersixvalverde (2005),* did win at Aintree the following year. The 2014 winner *On His Own* went on to finish a close 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Cheltenham Gold Cup in the same season with 2015 winner *Djakadam* also finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Gold Cup. \*7 wins since 2003.

**Thursday January 26<sup>th</sup> Gowran Park – 2m Beginners Chase:** W P Mullins has won 4 times (in 2017, 18, 19 & 23). All had odds of 4/1 or shorter (including two favourites).

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Cheltenham – 2m1f Triumph Hurdle Trial (4yo):** N Henderson has 3 wins (in 2015, 16 & 17). Two were unbeaten in their NH races whilst the 2016 winner was a surprise 25/1 winner being the stable's 2<sup>nd</sup> string having finished 2<sup>nd</sup> on its only start. <u>Race Fact:</u> *Defi Du Seuil* won the race in 2017 before winning the Triumph Hurdle (trained by P Hobbs).

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Cheltenham – (Gr 2) Cleeve Hurdle over 3m:** E Lavelle/A Coleman have won 3 times In 2019, 20 & 22) with *Paisley Park.* On each occasion the horse was 3<sup>rd</sup> or better on last run, 35-57 days earlier, and had odds of 5/1 or shorter.

Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Cheltenham – (Gr 2) 'Ballymore Novices' Hurdle over 2m 4f: A King has won 3 times (in 2015, 16 & 22). All last ran 43-56 days earlier, finishing 4<sup>th</sup> or better LTO.

Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Doncaster – (Gr 2) 'Lightning' Novices' Chase over 2m: N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2016, 20 & 21). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO and started as either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Doncaster – (Gr 2) 'River Don' Novices' Hurdle over 3m:** B Pauling has won 3 times (in 2016, 18 & 21). All were 3<sup>rd</sup> or better LTO with odds of up to 25/1 seen.

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – 2m 5f Beginners Chase:** W P Mullins/P Townend have won for 3 consecutive years (2018/20) with the trainer nothing up a further win in 2023. All were aged 6yo and started as favourites having last run 26-74 days earlier.

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – (Gr 3) 'Solerina' Mares Novices' Hurdle over 2m 2f:** W P Mullins has 3 consecutive wins (2014-16<sup>\*</sup>) & 2018, 2022, 2023 with all starting as sole/joint favourites having finished 3<sup>rd</sup> or better on their last run. <u>Race Fact:</u> The 2016 winner, *Limini*, went on to win the Mares Novices' Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival and the 2018 winner *Laurina* also won the same race at Cheltenham that year. 2019 winner *Honeysuckle* won the Mares hurdle at Cheltenham in 2020 & Champion Hurdle in 2021.

**Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> Fairyhouse – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 3 times (in 2017, 21 & 22). All were aged 6yo and started as favourites having last run 26-30 days earlier.

**Sunday January 29<sup>th</sup> Naas – (Gr 3) 'Limestone Lad' Hurdle over 2m:** W P Mullins/P Townend have won 4 times (in 2018, 20, 21 & 23). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites and had finished 3<sup>rd</sup> or better on their last <u>completed</u> race.

Sunday January 29<sup>th</sup> Naas – (Gr 3) Novices' Chase over 3m: Two trainers have a strong record in this race: <u>W P Mullins</u> has 4 wins (in 2016, 19, 20 & 22). All were either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO and started as either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>

favourites. <u>N Meade</u> now has 3 wins (in 2015, 18 & 23). None were favourites but all had odds of 7/2 or shorter.

**Sunday January 29<sup>th</sup> Naas – 2m 3f Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2017, 18, 20, 22 & 23). Only two of the winners was better than 4<sup>th</sup> LTO but all started as either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Tuesday January 31<sup>st</sup> Limerick – 2m (C&G) Maiden Hurdle:** W P Mullins has won 3 consecutive runnings (2020-23\*) with all starting as favourites. \*No race in 2021 due to Covid-19 restrictions.

**Thursday February 2<sup>nd</sup> Wincanton – 2m 5f (Mares) Novices' Hurdle:** P Nicholls has won 4 times (in 2014, 16, 20 & 23). Three of the four had won on their last completed run and were sent off as either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites. The other was 5<sup>th</sup> LTO and was a 4/1 second favourite.

**Thursday February 2<sup>nd</sup> Wincanton – 2m Novices' Handicap Chase:** Venetia Williams has won 3 times (in 2014, 16 & 20). All carried a weight of 10st 10lbs to 11<sup>st</sup> 7lbs and started at odds of 8/1 or shorter.

**Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) Juvenile Hurdle over 2m:** W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2015, 16, 18, 22 & 23). None started as favourites with odds of up to 14/1 seen. <u>Race Fact:</u> (2013 winner) *Our Conor &* (2021 winner) *Quilixios* and (2022 winner) *Vauban* all went on to win the Triumph Hurdle with four other winners since 2014 also placed in the Triumph Hurdle.

Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) 'Arkle' Novices' Chase over 2m 1f: W P Mullins has won 5 times (in 2015, 16, 18, 20 & 21). All were aged 6/7yo and also won their last race. <u>Race Fact:</u> Un De Sceaux (2015), Douvan (2016) & Footpad (2018) all went on to win the Arkle Chase at Cheltenham after winning here.

**Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) 'Paddy Power' Irish Gold Cup over 3m**: W P Mullins has won 3 times (in 2019, 21 & 23). All winners finished 4<sup>th</sup> or better on last start (within 37-47 days). All started as 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> The last winners of this race to win the Cheltenham Gold cup in the same year was *Sizing John* in 2017.

**Saturday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 2) NH Flat Race over 2m:** W P Mullins/P W Mullins have won 4 times (in 2018, 20, 21 & 22). All won LTO and started as favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> (2019 winner *Envoi Allen*) won the Cheltenham Bumper as did 2022 winner *Facile Vega* with two other winners subsequently runners up in the Cheltenham Race in 2020-21.

**Saturday February 5<sup>th</sup> Sandown – 2m 'Contenders' Hurdle:** N Henderson won in 2017, 2018 & 2019. All had finished 2<sup>nd</sup> or better on their last run and were very well backed at odds-on favouritism. <u>Race Fact:</u> Since 2003, three winners of the race went on to win the Champion Hurdle ~ *Rooster Booster, Binocular & Buveur D'air (twice).* 

**Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Sandown – 2m Handicap Chase:** P Nicholls/H Cobden have 3 wins (in 2019, 20 & 22). All wins were with *Dolos.* In addition K Lee/Jamie Moore have won the race 3 times (in 2014, 17 & 18). All had odds of 7/2 to 4/1.

Saturday February 5<sup>th</sup> Sandown – (Gr 1) 'Scilly Isles' Novices' Chase over 2m4f: N Henderson has won 4 times (in 2013, 14, 17 & 18). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites and also won LTO.

**Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Wetherby – 2m 5f Novices' Hurdle:** D Skelton/H Skelton have won 3 times (in 2018, 22 & 23). All were favourites.

**Saturday February 4<sup>th</sup> Wetherby – 3m 1f Hunter Chase:** Mrs J Dawson has won for 4 consecutive years (2013-16) with *Palypso De Creek.* Miss C V Hart rode each time with the horse well backed as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourite.

**Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – 2m 2f (Mares) Handicap Hurdle:** L P Cusack has won 3 times (in 2015-17) with *Who's That.* Always rested at lease 36 days before winning with highest weight carried being 10st 7lbs.

**Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) Dublin Chase over 2m 1f:** W P Mullins has won for 6 consecutive years (2018-23). Five of the six started as favourites. <u>Race Fact:</u> The last four winners record at Cheltenham in the QM Chase reads:  $2^{nd} - 5^{th} - DNR^* - 3^{rd} * DNR = Din not run at Cheltenham.$

All started as odds on favourites with *Honeysuckle* winning three times. <u>Race Fact:</u> Since the *Istabraq* era there have been four winners of this race that also went on to win the Cheltenham equivalent – *Brave Inca (2006), Hurricane Fly (2011 & 2013) & Honeysuckle (2021).* 

**Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) 'Tattersalls Ireland' Novices' Hurdle over 2m\*:** W P Mullins has 5 consecutive wins (2013-17) and also consecutive wins in (2019-23). Five of the nine started as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites whilst the other winners had odds of 4/1, 11/1, 12/1 & 14/1 respectively in a race where the trainer often makes multiple entries (with three runners in 2023). \* Prior to 2018, the race was run over two furlongs further. <u>Race Facts:</u> *Champagne Fever (2013), Vautour (2014), Klassical Dream (2019) & Appreciate It (2021)* all won this race before winning the Supreme Novices' Hurdle at Cheltenham. *Samcro (2018)* also won the race before winning the Ballymore Novices' Hurdle at Cheltenham.

Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 1) 'Ladbrokes' Novices' Chase over 2m 5f: W Mullins has won 6 times (in 2013, 14, 16, 20, 21 & 22). All had won at least once in current season finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> or better on last run (within 18-77 days). <u>Race Fact:</u> *Boston Bob (2013)* went on to win the Melling Chase at Aintree after winning here. *Monkfish (2021)* won the (Gr 1) Brown Advisory Novices Chase at Cheltenham.

Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr B) 'Liffey' Handicap Hurdle over 2m: C Byrnes has won for 3 consecutive years (2018-20). All were well backed with odds of 6/1 to 8/1 seen.

Sunday February 5<sup>th</sup> Leopardstown – (Gr 2) (Mares) NH Flat Race over 2m: W P Mullins has won 3 times (in 2018, 21 & 23). All had won on their first outing under NH rules although only one was a favourite and the others had odds of 16/1 & 18.1.

**Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Naas – 3m 1f Hunter Chase:** W P Mullins/P W Mullins have won 4 times with *Billaway.* <u>Race Fact:</u> After winning here the horse was twice 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Cheltenham Hunter Chase (2020/21) and also won the Cheltenham race in 2022.

**Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Naas – 2m NH Flat (4yo):** G Elliott/J J Codd have won 3 times (in 2020, 21 & 23). Two were 3<sup>rd</sup> on their only previous race and the other was a debutant. All had odds of 13/2 or shorter, including one favourite.

**Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Newbury – (Gr 2) 'Denman' Chase over 3m**: C Tizzard has 4 wins (in 2017, 18, 20 & 22) with *Native River*, who went on to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup> in the Cheltenham Gold cup after winning here, a triple winner. <u>Race Fact:</u> The 2015 winner *Coneygree* and 2018 winner *Native River* both won this race before winning the Cheltenham Gold Cup. \*2019 race moved to Ascot due to equine flu outbreak.

Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Newbury – (Gr 2) 'Game Spirit' Chase over 2m 1f: N Henderson has won 3 times (in 2017, 18 & 20). All were favourites. <u>Race Facts</u>; 2004 winner *Azertyuiop* won the QM chase in the same year as did *Master Minded* in 2008. 2012 winner *Sprinter Sacre* won the Arkle Chase in the same year and the QM Chase the following year. 2017 winner *Altior* went on to win the Arkle Chase at Cheltenham and in 2018 won the QM Chase after winning here.

**Saturday February 11<sup>th</sup> Newbury – (Gr 3) 'Betfair' Handicap Hurdle over 2m:** N Twiston-Davies has won 3 times (in 2014, 17 & 19<sup>\*</sup>). All finished 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> LTO with two sent off as favourites. \*2019 race moved to Ascot due to equine flu outbreak.

**Sunday February 12<sup>th</sup> Exeter – 2m 1f (Listed) Novices' Hurdle**: C Tizzard has 3 wins (in 2015, 17 & 18). All were aged 5yo with odds of 9/2 or shorter. <u>Race Fact:</u> Four of the last six winners have all gone on to win Gr 1 races at Sandown/Aintree).

**Sunday February 12<sup>th</sup> Exeter – 2m 1f NH Flat Race**: P Hobbs has won 3 times (in 2014, 15 & 16). All were sent off as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Sunday February 12<sup>th</sup> Navan – 2m Maiden Hurdle:** G Elliott/J Kennedy have won 3 times (in 2016, 19 & 22). G Elliott also won in 2023 when his main jockey was injured. All had odds of 9/1 or shorter.

**Sunday February 12<sup>th</sup> Navan – (Gr 2) 'Boyne' Hurdle over 2m 5f:** Two trainers have a strong record in this race: <u>G Elliott</u> has won for 4 consecutive years (2017-20). All were 5<sup>th</sup> or better LTO. <u>N Meade</u> has 3 wins (in 2016, 21 & 21). All had odds of 4/1 or shorter. <u>Race fact:</u> *Tiger Roll* won the 2019 renewal before going on to further Cheltenham & Grand National successes.

Friday February 10<sup>th</sup> Dundalk – 6f Rated Race: A McGuiness has won 3 times (2021-23). All were sole/joint favourites.

**Friday February 10<sup>th</sup> Dundalk – 2m Rated Race:** J P O'Brien has won 4 times (In 2019, 20, 21 & 23). All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Wednesday Feb 17<sup>th</sup> Wolverhampton – 1m 6f Apprentice Handicap:** A W Carroll has won 4 times (in 2012, 14, 15 & 16). All were 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> on last run 5-16 days earlier and started as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.

**Wednesday Feb 24<sup>th</sup> Kempton – 1m Apprentice Handicap:** A Carroll has won 3 times (in 2012, 13 & 15). All carried a weight of 9st 2lbs or more with longest winners odds seen 7/1.
