

# Catterick Trendsetters Guide ~ Wednesday July 23<sup>rd</sup>

Previous race trends (2015-24) can often help provide a short-list of potential winners in the current year's races. The percentage figure after the race details is the favourite's 'strike rate' in the race. Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the final declaration stage. Drawfacts assumes that the stalls are divided as low, middle & high.

In handicap races, horses that have won before off the same/higher ratings will be highlighted as 'well handicapped' – only racecard number(s) given

In the last five years some key statistics are:

Leading jockey – Jason Hart – 30 wins from 204 rides.

Leading trainer – T Easterby – 44 wins from 413 runners.

**2.30 – 7f Maiden (2yo) – Fav 70%:** New race in 2020 with 4/5 winners being sole/joint favourites. Stall 2 has produced 3 winners since 2020. Drawfacts: Low 60%; Middle 20%; High 20%. Trainers to watch: A Nicholls & C Johnston (1 win).

**3.00 – 7f Nursery (2yo):** New race in 2024.

**3.30 – 7f H/cap – Fav 33%:** New race in 2020 (divided in 2021). Three winners last ran here 14 days earlier (finished 1<sup>st</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> ). All six winners carried 9st 12lbs or less. Drawfacts: Low 33%; Middle 67%. Well handicapped: 1-3-7-11.

**4.00 – 1m 4f H/cap (3yo):** New race in 2025.

**4.30 – 1m 4f H/cap:** New race in 2023. Both winners to date carried 9st 9lbs and were 2<sup>nd</sup> favourites. Trainer to watch: C Johnston (1 win). Well handicapped: 4.

**5.00 – 6f H/cap – Fav 32%:** Due to race divisions in the past this event has seen 13 renewals since 2015. Three winners last ran 8 days earlier (no better than 4<sup>th</sup> LTO) with another three winners coming from stall 9. *Mews House* won the race in 2022 and is now 15lbs lower in the ratings. Trainer to watch: R Menzies (2 wins). Drawfacts: Low 7%; Middle 30%; High 63%. Well handicapped: 1-2-4-5-6-8.
