

Carlisle Trendsetters Guide ~ Saturday July 6th

Previous race trends (2014-23) can often help provide a short-list of potential winners in the current year's races. The percentage figure after the race details is the favourite's 'strike rate' in the race for the last ten years. Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the 5-day declaration stage. Drawfacts comments show the past record of winning stalls in the race – stalls divided as low-middle-high.

5.48 – 6f Apprentices Handicap – Fav 22%: 7/9 recent winners were 6th or better on their last run. Similarly 7/9 had odds of 9/1 or shorter. Drawfacts: Low 11%; Middle 67%; High 22%. Trainer to watch: T Easterby (won 2014 & 2021).

6.18 – 6f Novices Stakes for 2yo – Fav 33%: New race in 2021 with all three past winners last running 16-18 days earlier. Drawfacts: Low 33%; Middle 67%. Trainers to watch: K Burke (won 2023); T Easterby (won 2021).

6.48 – 5f Handicap – Fav 33%: New race in 2021. All three winners came from either stalls 7 or 8 and last ran 8-14 days earlier. Drawfacts: Middle 33%; High 67%.

7.20 – 1m 3f Maiden for 3yo+ Fillies: New race in 2022. Both winners were 4th LTO and started as 2nd favourites. Both also last ran 24-29 days earlier.

7.50 – 7f Nursery Handicap (2yo): New race in 2024.

8.20 – 1m Handicap – Fav 22%: T Easterby's three winner's since 2016 were all 4th or better LTO and carried a weight of 9st 10lbs to 9st 12lbs. All nine recent winners had last run 8-28 days earlier. 8/9 winners had odds of 9/1 or shorter, with other 25/1. Drawfacts: Low 22%; Middle 56%; High 22%. Trainers to watch: T Easterby (won 2016, 22 & 23) C&M Johnston (won 2021); R Fahey (won 2017).

8.50 – 1m 1f Handicap – Fav 40%: New race in 2019 with two divisions last year, thus only run five times before. 4/5 past winners had finished either 1st/2nd on last run (other was 6th LTO) with odds of 12/1 or shorter seen. Drawfacts: Low 20%; Middle 40%; High 40%. Trainer to watch: N Tinkler (won 2019).
