Carlisle Trendsetters Guide ~ Monday 13th November

Previous race trends (2013-22) can often help provide a short-list of potential winners in the current year's races. The percentage figure after the race details is the favourite's 'strike rate' in the race. Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the 5-day declaration stage. The 2022 meeting was abandoned due to adverse weather.

12.35 – 2m 1f Maiden Hurdle (Fav 33%): Race run three times before with two winners running for the first time under NH rules with the other 2nd on its last run. All had odds of 13/2 or shorter. <u>Trainers to watch:</u> D Skelton (won 2021), B Pauling (won 2020).

1.05 – 2m Graduation Chase (Fav 20%): Race run five times before with just one favourite and two 2nd favourites winning. 6yo horses have won 4/5 races. All winners were 5th or better on their last run.

1.40 – 2m 1f (Mares) Handicap Hurdle (Fav 25%): New race in 2018. No past winner had finished better than 3rd on its last race with winner's odds of up to 11/1 seen. The last three winners were all ridden by jockeys claiming a weight allowance of 5/7lbs. <u>Trainer to watch:</u> S R Crawford (won 2018).

2.15 – 2m 4f Novices Limited Handicap Chase: New race in 2021.

2.50 – 2m 3f+ Novices' Handicap Hurdle: New race in 2021.

3.20 – 2m 4f Handicap Chase (Fav 27%): All nine past winners had odds of 12/1 or shorter with four of the last five winners ridden by jockeys claiming a 3/5lbs weight allowance. <u>Trainers to watch:</u> L V Russell (won 2021 & 2018), N Richards (won 2013).

3.50 – 2m 1f NH Flat Race: New race in 2023.
