

Sunday Mar 26th – Carlisle Trendsetters Guide

Previous race trends (2013-22) can often help provide a shortlist of potential winners in the current year's races. The favourite's win ratio is shown in brackets after the race details. Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the final declaration stage.

1.50 – 2m 3f+ Novices' Hurdle (56%): New race in 2015. 6/7 past winners were either 1st/2nd favourites with one surprise (40/1) winner in 2021. 6/7 past winners had finished 4th or better LTO (excluding point to point form). Trainer to watch: S R Crawford (won 2016).

2.25 – 2m Handicap Chase (n/a): New race in 2021. Both winners to date were 5th or better LTO (22-26 days earlier) and carried a weight of 10st 3lbs to 10st 4lbs. Trainer to watch: S Coltherd (won 2021).

3.00 – 2m 1f (Mares) Handicap Hurdle (n/a): New race in 2021. Both winners to date were 4th or better LTO with odds of 13/2 or shorter. The winning jockeys involved were both claiming a weight allowance of 3/5lbs. Trainer to watch: D McCain (won 2022).

3.35 – 2m 4f Handicap Chase (n/a): New race in 2021. Both winners to date were either 1st/2nd LTO (10-17 days earlier). Winner's weights were 10st to 10st 2lbs. *Croagh Patrick* is seeking a repeat win in the race and is now 1lb higher in the handicap ratings than last year's win. Trainer to watch: Sam England (won 2022).

4.10 – 3m 1f Handicap Hurdle (n/a): New race in 2023.

4.45 – 3m+ Handicap Chase (n/a): New race in 2021. Both winners to date were either 1st/2nd LTO (12-27 days earlier). In the betting both had odds of 15/2 or shorter. Trainer to watch: Sam England (won 2022).

5.18 – 2m 1f NH Flat Race (50%): New race in 2019 with three previous renewals. All three past winners were either 1st/2nd favourites. One was making its debut and the others both had two previous runs, finishing 4th or better LTO (30-58 days earlier). All three were aged 5yo.
