

Carlisle Trendsetters Guide ~ Friday May 29th

Previous race trends (2016-25) can often help provide a short-list of potential winners in the current year's races. The percentage figure in brackets after the race details is the favourite's 'strike rate' in the race for the last ten years. No meeting took place in 2020 due to Covid-19.

Trainers who have won the race before are also highlighted if they had an entry at the final declaration stage.

Drawfacts comments show the past record of winning stalls in the race – stalls divided as low-middle-high.

In handicap races, horses that have previously won off the same/higher ratings will be flagged as 'well handicapped' with race card numbers shown.

In the last five years some key statistics are:

Leading jockey – P Mulrennan 18 wins.

Leading trainer – T Easterby 27 wins.

2.10 – 1m 1f Apprentice H/cap: New race in 2026.

2.40 – 5f Novice Stakes for 2yo (Fav 33%): 8/9 winners had odds of 8/1 or shorter (other 12/1). 4/9 winners were making their racecourse debuts. Stall 4 has provided 4 winners since 2017. Trainer to watch: K Burke (1 win). Draw Facts: Middle 55%; High 45%.

3.10 – 5f H/cap: New race in 2025. Well handicapped: 2-3-4-7-8-10.

3.40 – 6f H/cap for 3yo (Fav 50%): 8/10 winners had odds of 13/2 or shorter. 8/10 winners finished 3rd or worse LTO. Trainers to watch: N Tinkler (2 wins), T Easterby & J Goldie (1 win each). Drawfacts: Low 50%; Middle 20%; High 30%.

4.10 – 1m 3f H/cap (Fav 0%): New race in 2019. 5/6 winners had finished 3rd 4th 5th or 6th LTO. No winning favourites but two winning 2nd favourites seen. Trainers to watch: J Goldie & P Kirby (1 win); Draw facts: Low 50%; Middle 16%; High 34%. Well handicapped: 4-5-6.

4.45 & 5.15 – 7f H/cap (Fav 25%): New race in 2023. All four winners carried a weight of 9st 5lbs to 9st 8lbs. 5yo have won 3 of the four races. Three winners finished no better than 4th LTO. Trainer to watch: I Jardine (1 win). Draw Facts: Low 25%; Middle 25%; High 50%. Well handicapped: (Div 1) 3-4-6-7-8 (Div 2) 1-2-8.
