

DAYS LAST RAN STATS – JULY/AUGUST 2023

Regular racing followers may have already picked up on the fact that certain high-profile races are won by horses with a similar 'preparation route'. What I have tried to do here is list races where horses appear to have had a similar preparation race before winning the named races at least three times in the last ten years. As we all know connections of horses like to keep as much information to themselves about future running plans/targets but if their horses follow certain 'patterns' that will often speak for itself!

The statistics will also capture some lower-class races but again the patterns of races can often be very informative.

The text will often refer to number of days since the last run but where that race is also a common trend, I have referred to that fact also. Indeed, where higher profile race days have changed in the last ten years I have included still.

The lists on the following pages are mostly dated as in 2022 with flat meetings first then jumps meetings below.

FLAT MEETINGS

Saturday July 1st Chester – 1m 4f Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 14 days earlier. All carried a weight of 9st 7lbs to 9st 13lbs. A further 3 winners had last run 22 days earlier all with odds of 4/1 to 17/2.

Saturday July 1st Curragh – (Gr 2) 'Airlie Stud' Stakes for 2yo Fillies: Raced upgraded from Gr3 in 2020. Since 2013, three winners had last run 11* days earlier ~ finishing no better than 4th

Saturday July 1st Curragh – (Gr 1) 'Pretty Polly' Stakes over 1m 2f: Since 2014, four winners had last run 23* days earlier ~ finishing 4th or better LTO.

Sunday July 2nd Curragh - (Gr 1) Irish Derby over 1m 4f for 3yo: Since 2014, seven winners last ran 21/28 days earlier in the Epsom Derby*, with five finishing either 1st/2nd/3rd at Epsom. We have also seen the 6th and 10th placed finishers from Epsom winning here.

Wednesday July 5th Epsom – 1m 4f 'Ladies Derby' Handicap: Since 2016, three winners have won the race after running at York in the Queen Mother Handicap for lady riders 19/26 days earlier, finishing 4th or better on its last run.

Friday July 7th Beverley – 1m 4f Handicap: Since 2016, three winners had last run 10 days earlier, all finishing 6th or better on their last run.

Friday July 7th Beverley – 7f Seller: Since 2017, three winners had last run 13 days earlier where they finished 4th 5th 3rd.

Friday July 7th Sandown – (Listed) Dragon Stakes for 2yo over 5f: Since 2015, three winners had last run 15 days earlier. All had odds of 3/1 or shorter. Also, since 2019, three winners had last run 16 days earlier finishing 4th 2nd 1st LTO.

Friday July 7th Sandown – (Listed) Gala Stakes over 1m 2f: Since 2019, three winners had last run 17 days earlier at Royal Ascot where they finished 3rd 5th 16th.

Friday July 7th Sandown – 7f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2014, four winners had last run 14* days earlier, with all finishing 6th or better on their last run. *Race since moved to Friday from Saturday so will now be 13 days.

Saturday July 8th Carlisle – 1m Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 10 days earlier. All had odds of 15/2 or shorter when winning here.

Saturday July 8th Haydock – 1m 6f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2018, three winners had last run 16 days earlier at Royal Ascot ~ all were unplaced on their last run.

Saturday July 8th Sandown – 'Coral Challenge' Handicap over 1m: Since 2015, three winners had last run 21 days earlier, with all finishing 4th or better on their last run. Also, since 2021, a further three winners had last run at Royal Ascot 17 days earlier finishing 5th or worse there.

Saturday July 8th Sandown – (Gr 3) Coral Charge over 5f: Since 2015, three winners had last run 21 days earlier, winning LTO.

Monday July 10th Chepstow – 2m Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 21 days earlier where they finished 1st 4th 4th LTO.

Tuesday July 11th Brighton – 7f (Fillies) Handicap: Since 2015, three winners had last run at Brighton 7 days earlier, all finishing 8th or better LTO and starting as sole/joint favourites.

Tuesday July 11th Pontefract – (Listed) 'Pipalong' Fillies Stakes over 1m: Since 2016, four winners had last run 20 days earlier ~ three ran at Royal Ascot and the other in a listed event at Chelmsford.

Thursday July 13th Carlisle – 6f Handicap: Since 2018, three winners had last run 5 days earlier, finishing 5th or better LTO.

Thursday July 13th Epsom – 6f Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run at Epsom, 7 days earlier, finishing 3rd, 5th & 7th.

Thursday July 13th Newmarket – (Gr 3) 'Bahrain Trophy' over 1m 5f: Since 2014, five winners had last run 20 days earlier at Royal Ascot. One ran in the Queens Vase (finished 1st) with four running in the King Edward VII Stakes (finishing 2nd, 4th, 4th & 6th).

Thursday July 13th Newmarket – (Gr 2) 'July Stakes' over 6f for 2yo: Since 2016, six winners had last run 21-23 days earlier at Royal Ascot. One was 1st in the Windsor Castle Stakes and four last ran in the in the Coventry Stakes (three were 2nd there and the other 7th). Another Royal Ascot runner won the race after finishing 3rd in the Norfolk Stakes.

Thursday July 13th Newmarket – 6f 'Bet 365' Handicap for 3yo: Since 2015, six winners had last run 26/27 days earlier at York in a valuable handicap race where they all finished in the first five.

Friday July 14th Chepstow – 7f Handicap (3yo+): Since 2019, three winners had last run 10 days earlier. All carried 9st 6lbs or more, had odds of 11/2 or shorter and came from one of the highest three stalls used in the race.

Friday July 14th Newmarket – (Gr 2) 'Duchess of Cambridge' Stakes over 6f for 2yo Fillies: Since 2015, six winners had last run at Royal Ascot in the Albany Stakes 21 days earlier. They finished 1st 5th 1st 1st 2nd & 4th in that race.

Friday July 14th Newmarket – (Gr 1) 'Falmouth' Fillies Stakes over 1m: Since 2016, five winners had last run at Royal Ascot in the Coronation Stakes 21 days earlier. (finishing 3rd - 2nd - 1st - 1st - 10th there) . Additionally a further four winners had last run 23/24 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Duke of Cambridge Stakes (finishing 1st 1st 4th 1st there).

Friday July 14th York – 5f Handicap: Since 2014, four winners last ran 13 days earlier. The last two such winners last ran at York, finishing 3rd/4th.

Saturday July 15th Ascot – 5f Heritage Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 21 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Wokingham Stakes where they finished 5th, 9th & 2nd.

Saturday July 15th Ascot – (Gr 2) 'Summer Mile' Stakes: Since 2017, four winners had last run in the Queen Anne Stakes, 25 days earlier, finishing 2nd (twice, 7th & 6th. *Beat The Bank* achieved back to back wins in 2018/19 although was fatally injured in the 2019 race.

Saturday July 15th Chester – (Listed) 'City Plate' Stakes over 7f: Since 2016, three winners had last run 14 days earlier . All had odds of 7/1 or shorter when winning here.

Saturday July 13th Navan – 5f Handicap: Since 2016, three winners had last run 8 days earlier at Bellewstown, finishing 5th, 5th & 6th there.

Saturday July 15th Newmarket – 7f Fillies Handicap for 3yo: Since 2014, four winners had last run 22/23 days earlier in the Sandringham Handicap at Royal Ascot where they finished 12th , 15th, 12th & 6th.

Saturday July 15th Newmarket – 1m 'Bet 365' Handicap for 3yo: Since 2017, four winners had last run 23 days earlier in the Britannia Handicap at Royal Ascot where they finished 14th 11th 3rd 24th . All had odds of 12/1 or shorter.

Saturday July 15th Newmarket – (Gr 1) 'July Cup' over 6f: Since 2015, four winners had last run 22 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Commonwealth Cup (finishing 1st 2nd 4th 1st .

Saturday July 15th York – (Listed) City Wall Stakes over 5f: Since 2015, four winners had last run 25 days earlier. Three ran in the Kinds Stand Stakes at Royal Ascot, finishing 8th , 19th & 9th whilst the other was 4th at Beverley in a conditions race.

Monday July 11th Wolverhampton – 1m 6f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2013, three winners had last run 13 days earlier, all finishing 3rd or 4th on their last run.

Tuesday July 18th Beverley – 7.5f Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 11 days earlier finishing either 3rd or 5th LTO.

Tuesday July 18th Beverley – 5f Handicap: Since 2016, four winners had last run 13 days earlier where they finished 2nd 4th 4th 9th .

Wednesday July 17th Catterick – 5f Handicap: Since 2013, three winners last ran 4 days earlier in a handicap race at Hamilton. Two won that race and the other finished 5th there.

Wednesday July 18th Yarmouth– 5f Handicap: Since 2013, three winners last ran 26 days earlier, finishing either 2nd or 3rd in handicap races at Newmarket (twice) & Warwick.

Thursday July 18th Chepstow – 1m Handicap: Since 2015, three winners had last run 16 days earlier ~ they all had odds of 9/2 or shorter and finished 4th or better on their last run.

Thursday July 14th Epsom – 7f Maiden for 2yo: Since 2015, three winners had last run 14 days earlier ~ they all had odds of 7/1 or shorter.

Friday July 15th Newmarket – 5f 'Conditions Stakes': Since 2014, three winners had last run 6 days earlier. All last ran in the listed 'City Walls' Stakes at York where they finished 4th/5th/6th.

Friday July 15th Nottingham – 6f Nursery Handicap (2yo): Since 2013, three winners had last run 13 days earlier. All ran in different races LTO, finishing 1st/3rd/8th.

Saturday July 16th Curragh – 7f Maiden for 2yo: Since 2015, three winners had last run 20 days earlier in a maiden race at the Curragh, finishing 2nd, 4th & 7th. Race Fact: 2013 winner of this race *Australia* went on to win the Epsom Derby the following year.

Saturday July 16th Curragh – (Gr 3) 'Anglesey Stakes' over 6.5f for 2yo: Since 2015, three winners had last run 21 days earlier at the Curragh. Two had finished 2nd in the Gr 2 'Railway Stakes' and the other had won a maiden race.

Saturday July 16th Curragh – 7f Handicap: Since 2013, three winners had last raced 20 days earlier in a handicap race at the Curragh, with two winning and the other finishing 6th.

Saturday July 18th Haydock – 1m 6f Handicap: Since 2011, three winners had last run 21 days earlier. All last ran at different races/courses and finished 2nd/6th/7th LTO.

Saturday July 20th Newbury – Gr 3 'Hackwood Stakes' over 6f: Since 2010, four winners had last run at Royal Ascot 28 days earlier. One had won the Wokingham Handicap with the other three finishing 4th, 8th & 16th in the Gr 1 'Diamond Jubilee' Stakes.

Saturday July 16th Newmarket – 6f Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 7 days earlier. All last ran at different tracks and finished 2nd/3rd LTO.

Saturday July 16th Newmarket – 1m Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 30 days earlier. Two were favourites and the other a 16/1 shot.

Sunday July 18th Redcar – 6f Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 18 days earlier. All had won their penultimate race.

Wednesday July 24th Catterick – 6f Handicap: Since 2010, three winners had last run 14 days earlier in a similar race at Catterick where they had finished 2nd/3rd/4th. A further 3 winners had last run 8 days earlier with all carrying a weight of 9st 8lbs to 9st 10lbs.

Wednesday July 24th Catterick – 7f Selling Stakes for 2yo: Since 2011, four winners had last run 4 days earlier at Ripon in a similar selling race. Three won that race with the other 3rd LTO.

Thursday July 21st Leopardstown – (Gr 3) 'Silver Flash' Stakes over 7f for 2yo Fillies: Since 2013, three winners had last run 27 days earlier at the Curragh with two winning and the other unplaced there. Race Fact: The 2019 winner, *Love*, went on to win the 1000Gns & Oaks as a 3yo.

Thursday July 22nd Sandown – 1m 2f Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 21 days earlier. Two had last run at Epsom (finished 1st/5th) with the other finishing 3rd at Yarmouth LTO.

Thursday July 25th Yarmouth – 6f Handicap: Since 2016, three winners had last run 8 days earlier. All were 1st/2nd LTO.

Friday July 22nd Newmarket – 1m (Fillies) Handicap: Since 2016, *Trulee Scrumptious* has won the race three times after a last run 7 days earlier at Newmarket (finished 2nd/4th/6th). The 2021 winner also ran 7 days earlier, finishing 5th at Nottingham.

Saturday July 23rd Ascot – (Gr 3) 'Princess Margaret Stakes' over 6f for 2yo Fillies: Since 2013, six winners had last run 15/16* days earlier at Newmarket in the Gr 2 'Duchess of Cambridgeshire' Stakes. Four finished 2nd in that race and the others were 3rd and 5th.
*Race run a day later in 2020.

Saturday July 24th Ascot – 1m Handicap for 3yo: Since 2015, three winners had last run 37 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Britannia Handicap. In that race they had finished 12th, 13th & 17th.

Saturday July 23rd Ascot – 7f 'International Handicap Stakes': Since 2015, three winners had last run 14/15 days earlier at Newmarket in the Bunbury Cup. One won that race, one was 3rd and the other was well beaten in 18th place there.

Saturday July 25th Ascot – (Gr 1) 'King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes over 1m 4f: Since 2010, three winners had last run 35 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Hardwick Stakes. In that race they had finished 1st/2nd/3rd.

Saturday July 25th Newmarket – 6f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2016, three winners had last run 16 days earlier in a valuable handicap at Newmarket (finishing 5th, 7th & 11th).

Saturday July 23rd Salisbury – 1m (Gentlemen Amateurs) Handicap: Since 2013, three winners last ran 16 days earlier. One won a selling race at Bath with the other two running in an amateurs race at Newbury where they finished 7th & 8th.

Saturday July 23rd Salisbury – 6f Maiden for 2yo: Since 2017, three winners last ran 15 days earlier. All finished 5th LTO at either Ascot or Newmarket.

Saturday July 23rd York – 6f 'Sky Bet Dash' Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 8 days earlier. None were better than 5th LTO.

Saturday July 23rd York – (Gr 2) 'Skybet' York Stakes over 1m 2f: Since 2013, three winners had last run 21 days earlier. Two were 3rd and the other 5th LTO.

Sunday July 28th Pontefract – (Listed) Pomfret Stakes over 1m: Since 2010, three winners had last run 29 days earlier. Two ran in a listed event at Windsor (finishing 1st & 3rd) and the other in a Gr 3 race at Newmarket (finished 7th).

Tuesday July 26th Beverley – 5 Handicap: Since 2014 three winners last ran 8 days earlier at Beverley finishing 3rd or better on their last run.

Tuesday July 26th Goodwood – 1m 2f Handicap: Since 2014, four winners last ran 17 days earlier at York in the John Smiths Cup. One finished third, two finished 6th, and the other was 14th at York.

Tuesday July 26th Goodwood – (Gr 1) 'Goodwood Cup' over 2m: The race was upgraded to

Gr 1 status in 2017 and this seems to have re-kindled the running of Ascot Gold Cup horses here again. Since 2018, four winners last ran 40 days earlier in the Gold Cup at Royal Ascot with all winning at the Royal meeting.

Wednesday July 27th Goodwood –1m 4f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2013, four winners had last run 18/21 days earlier (race moved from Saturday to Wednesday in 2017). All were 3rd or better in their last races.

Wednesday July 27th Goodwood – (Gr 1) Sussex Stakes over 1m: Since 2013, five winners last ran 43 days earlier at Royal Ascot. Two ran in the St James' Palace Stakes (finishing 1st/2nd) and the other horses all ran in the Queen Anne Stakes (where two won and the other was 3rd).

Wednesday July 28th Goodwood – 1m 2f Fillies Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 18 days earlier where they finished 1st/2nd LTO.

Thursday July 29th Epsom – 1m 4f Handicap: Since 2017, three winners had last run 14 days earlier with all 3rd or better LTO.

Thursday July 29th Epsom – 8.5f Handicap: Since 2012, three winners had last run 7 days earlier. All were 1st/2nd on their last run.

Thursday July 28th Goodwood – 1m 2f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2013, four winners had last run 19 days earlier finishing 6th or better LTO.

Thursday July 28th Goodwood – (Gr 2) 'Richmond Stakes' for 2yo over 6f: Since 2014, four winners had last run 21 days earlier. They all last ran at Newmarket in a Gr 2 race with three winning there and the others 2nd.

Friday July 30th Goodwood – (Gr 3) 'Glorious Stakes' over 1m 4f: Since 2014 three winners had last run 22 days earlier at Newmarket in the Gr 2 'Princess of Wales' Stakes where they had finished either 2nd/3rd. A further three winners (since 2012) had last run 41 days earlier in the Hardwicke Stakes at Royal Ascot (finishing 3rd, 6th & 10th).

Friday July 30th Goodwood – (Gr 2) 'King George Stakes' over 5f: Since 2012 three winners had last run 20 days earlier. Two ran at Newmarket in the July Cup where they had finished 4th/9th. The other won a listed race at York LTO. More recently four winners had last run 45 days earlier at Royal Ascot, finishing 11th - 2nd - 2nd and 1st in the Gr 1 Kings Stand Stakes.

Friday July 29th Musselburgh – 1m 5f Handicap (Amateurs): Since 2017, three winners had last run 9 days earlier, finishing 5th or better LTO.

Friday July 30th Newmarket – 7f Handicap: Since 2013, three winners had last run 21 days earlier. All carried a weight of 9st 4lbs or less.

Saturday July 31st Doncaster – 1m 2f Handicap: Since 2012, four winners had last run 21 days earlier. All had odds of 8/1 or shorter.

Saturday July 31st Galway – 7f Handicap: Since 2012, four winners had last run at Galway 4/5* days earlier (finished 3rd, 5th, 1st, 1st & 2nd). * Race moved from Friday to Saturday from 2020 onwards.

Saturday July 31st Goodwood – 1m 1f Apprentices' Handicap: Since 2013, three winners had last run 21 days earlier where they finished 3rd or better.

Saturday July 31st Lingfield – 1m Apprentices Handicap: Since 2012, three winners had last run 7 days earlier (with two winning and the other 3rd LTO).

Saturday July 31st Newmarket – 6f Nursery (2yo Fillies); Since 2012, three winners had last run 8 days earlier. The last two had run at Thirsk (finished 1st & 5th).

Sunday July 31st Chester – (Listed) Queensferry Stakes over 6f: Since 2014, four winners had last run 22 days earlier, finishing 9th or better LTO.

Sunday July 31st Chester – 6f Conditions Stakes for 2yo: Since 2014, three winners had last run 16 days earlier, also winning their last race.

Thursday August 1st Galway – 8.5f Handicap: Since 2012, three winners had last run 7 days earlier. None were better than 5th LTO and all had odds between 9/2 and 10/1.

Friday August 2nd Galway – 1m 4f Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 4 days earlier (Finished 3rd, 1st & 4th). All had odds of 5/1 or shorter.

Sunday July 31st Galway – 8.5f Handicap for 3yo: Since 2013, three winners last ran 16 days earlier (one was 2nd, one third and the other unplaced).

Sunday July 31st Galway – 7f Handicap: Since 2014, six winners last ran here 5 days earlier Three were trained by B Ellison and three by A McGuinness (triple winner, *Current Option*).

Monday August 1st Carlisle – 6f Handicap (Pro-Am Lady Riders): Since 2014, three winners had last run 10 days earlier finishing 2nd, 4th, & 6th on their last runs.

Monday August 2nd Windsor – 6f Maiden for 2yo Fillies: Since 2011, four winners had last run 14 days earlier, all finishing 5th or better LTO.

Tuesday August 3rd Nottingham – 1m Handicap: Since 2015, three winners had last run 18 days earlier, all finishing 5th or better LTO.

Wednesday August 4th Yarmouth – 1m 6f Handicap: Since 2019, three winners had all last run 12 days earlier, finishing 5th or better LTO.

Thursday August 4th Leopardstown – 1m 7f Handicap: Since 2018, all three winners last ran 19 days earlier at the Curragh. One was 2nd in a maiden's race and the last two had finished 3rd & 15th in the Ladies Derby.

Friday August 5th Newmarket – 6f Handicap: Since 2015, four winners had last run 13 days earlier with all starting as sole/joint favourites.

Friday August 5th Thirsk – 7f Conditions Stakes: Since 2016, three winners had last run 27 days earlier. One was 2nd LTO and the others unplaced on their last start.

Friday August 5th Tipperary – (Listed) Churchill Stakes over 7.5f (2yo): Since 2014, three winners had last run 15 days earlier, finishing 2nd/3rd LTO.

Saturday August 6th Ascot – 5f 'Shergar Dash' Handicap: Since 2015, four winners had last run 7 days earlier at Goodwood in either the Stewards Cup or its consolation race, Stewards Sprint. Most finished down the field there in 8th, 15th, 18th & 25th place.

Saturday August 6th Ascot – 1m (Round) Handicap: Since 2014, three winners had last run 14 days earlier finishing 5th or better LTO.

Saturday August 7th Ayr – 1m Handicap (Lady Riders): Since 2017, all three winners had last run 19 days earlier, finishing 4th or better LTO.

Saturday August 8th Haydock – 6f Handicap: Since 2012, three winners had last run 13 days earlier. Two had run at York (finished 5th & 10th there) with the other 4th in a race at Pontefract.

Saturday August 8th Haydock – (Gr 3) 'Rose of Lancaster' Stakes over 1m 2f: Since 2014, three winners had last run 20/21 days earlier in a listed race at Newbury with two winning there and the other 2nd.

Saturday August 7th Newmarket – (Gr 3) 'Sweet Solera' Stakes over 7f for 2yo Fillies: Since 2015, three winners had last run 29 days earlier, with non better than 3rd LTO.

Saturday August 10th Redcar – 1m Handicap: Since 2010, four winners had last run 7 days earlier at Thirsk (Summer Cup Handicap) where they finished 2nd, 4th, 5th & 6th.

Monday August 9th Ayr – 1m 2f Handicap: Since 2015, three winners had last run 9 days earlier, finishing 2nd/3rd/4th.

Tuesday August 10th Nottingham – 5f Conditions Stakes: Since 2012, three winners had last run 25 days earlier. All carried a weight between 8st 11lbs & 9st.

Wednesday August 10th Gowran Park – 9.5f Handicap: Since 2019, four* winners had last run 18 days earlier at Gowran Park, finishing 2nd 12th 8th 8th LTO. *2019 race was divided.

Thursday August 15th Beverley – 2m Handicap: Since 2013, three winners had last run 9 days earlier, finishing 1st or 2nd LTO.

Thursday August 15th Beverley – 8.5f Handicap for Amateur Riders: Since 2010, three winners had last run 10 days earlier. One was 3rd in a lady riders race at Brighton whilst the others had finished 9th & 1st in an apprentices handicap at Newcastle.

Friday Aug 14th Newbury – 1m 5f Handicap: Since 2012, three winners had last run 23 days earlier and finished 1st or 2nd LTO.

Saturday Aug 13th Newbury – (Listed) 'Denford Stakes' (2yo) over 7f: Since 2011, three winners had last run 21 days earlier. All were 4th or better LTO with odds of 11/2 or shorter.

Saturday Aug 13th Newbury – 7f Handicap: Since 2013, four winners had last run 21 days earlier. Two ran in the Ascot International Handicap (finishing 4th & 17th) one was a winner of another Ascot race and the other ran in York's Skybet Dash (finished 8th).

Saturday August 13th Newmarket – 7f Nursery Handicap for 2yo: Since 2013, four winners had last run 14 days earlier. Two last ran in a Newmarket nursery (finished 3rd & 4th). Another was 1st in a Newmarket Novices' race and the other won a maiden at Doncaster. Additionally, since 2020, all three winners had last run 16 days earlier, finishing 4th or better LTO.

Saturday Aug 13th Ripon – 6f 'Hornblower' Stakes for 2yo: Since 2014, three winners had last run 20 days earlier where they also won their last race (at Carlisle/Pontefract). In addition, since 2013, three winners had last run 18 days earlier in either a Gr 2 or Gr 3 race at Goodwood finishing 5th - 10th - 3rd.
