

## NEWMARKET (JULY MEETING) 10 YEAR TRENDS

A brief summary of key trends is detailed below for each race over the three-day meeting - trends alone will not usually find winners but they may help you to draw up a short-list and then use your own skill and judgement to find that elusive winner! The figure after each race name/detail is the favourites win rate e.g. 5 wins in 10 years = 50%. The main race of the day is also highlighted. ### THURSDAY

**6F MAIDEN FOR 2YO FILLIES (16%):** The race was divided in 2015 & 2016 making it 12 races over the last 10 years. Of these five were making their debuts, five had run just once (finishing 6<sup>th</sup> or better) and two had two previous runs finishing 7<sup>th</sup> or better in both of them. The betting is usually a fair guide with 8/12 winners having odds of 6/1 or shorter. The others were 10/1, 12/1 and 20/1(twice). Stall 2 has provided three winners since 2015 and W Buick is leading jockey on three wins since 2015.

**(Gr 3) BAHRAIN TROPHY over 1M 5F (20%):** The last ten winners were all 6<sup>th</sup> or better LTO. The most impressive training statistic is that John Gosden has won the race for three of the last ten years. All were 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites in the betting. Indeed, well backed horses (7/1 or less) have won the past ten renewals. A last run 20-48 days earlier is also a common feature with six winners since 20013 coming here after running at Royal Ascot 20 days earlier. Of these two last ran in the Queens Vase with a 2<sup>nd</sup> place or better seen whilst four had run in the King Edward VII Stakes finishing 6<sup>th</sup> or better. Three winners since 2014 came from stall 4.

**(Gr 2) JULY STAKES over 6F FOR 2YO (30%):** The Hannon yard has won 5 of the last 10 renewals with their last win in 2021. A 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> place on last run was also a common factor for nine of the last ten winners. Overall 7/10 past winners finished 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on their last start (21-40 days earlier). Seven of the last ten winners came here after running at Royal Ascot. Three ran in the Windsor Castle (finishing 1<sup>st</sup>~2<sup>nd</sup>~1<sup>st</sup> ) three ran in the Coventry Stakes (finishing 2<sup>nd</sup>~2<sup>nd</sup>~7<sup>th</sup> ) and the other was 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Norfolk Stakes .

**6F 'BET 365' HANDICAP for 3yo (0%):** Favourite backers tend to fare badly in this race with no winner and just two second favourites winning in the last ten years with several long-priced winners at 33/1. 25/1 and 40/1 since 2014. The key form race to follow here is the competitive sprint run at York 26 days earlier ~ six of the last nine winners last ran there, finishing 5<sup>th</sup> or better. The hottest stall in the race is stall 19 (six wins/places in last 10 years) whilst neither stall 4 or 7 have produced even a placed runner in the last 10 years. **(Gr 2) PRINCESS OF WALES STAKES over 1M 4F (10%):** M Johnston has won 3 times since 2013 with all finishing 8<sup>th</sup> or better at Royal Ascot (Hardwicke Stakes) 19 days earlier. Stall 1 has produced three winners since 2015.

**(LISTED) SIR HENRY CECIL STAKES over 1M for 3yo (33%):** A new race in 2013. So far, the Jersey Stakes form at Royal Ascot has proved to be the best form guide here with three of the last nine winners finishing 10<sup>th</sup> or better in that race 22 days earlier.

**1M HANDICAP (16%):** There was a shock 50/1 winner in 2011 but since then all winners had odds of 7/1 or shorter. 9/10 recent winners carried a weight of 9st 11lbs or less.

## FRIDAY

**7F MAIDEN FOR 2YO C&G (45%):** Eleven past races as 2017 saw two divisions of the race. Of these races five were won by debutants with the remainder won by horses which were 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> on their only other start. The horses which had run previously all had odds of 7/1 or shorter. Just one of the debutants started as favourites with the others having odds of 7/1 to 25/1. The Hannon & Appleby yards have both sent out three winners since 2014. James Doyle has ridden four of the last seven winners.

**1M 2F 'BET 365 HANDICAP' FOR 3YO (0%):** M Johnston has won the race 6 times (2013-16) & 2018, 2020 with six different jockeys! Frankie Dettori has not won this race for the stable previously. All of the stable's winners were fairly easy to back at odds of 13/2 to 25/1. Overall 9/10 recent winners had odds of 12/1 or shorter. Lowest weight carried in last 10 years was 8st 5lbs.

**(GR 2) 'DUCHESS OF CAMBRIDGE STAKES' OVER 6F FOR 2YO FILLIES (45%):** To many this will still be known as the Cherry Hinton Stakes! Seven of the last 10 winners had last run at Royal Ascot. Five ran in the Albany Stakes (finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup>). A further two previous winners last ran in the Queen Mary Stakes finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> there. Top jockey in the race is R L Moore with three wins from the last eight renewals.

**1M 6F 'BET 365 TROPHY' HANDICAP (25%):** New race in 2018. Two of the four winners to date were trained by M Johnston. All winners were 6<sup>th</sup> or better LTO with odds of 10/1 or shorter. All carried a weight of 9st 4lbs or less.

**(GR 1) FALMOUTH STAKES over 1M (30%):** Of the last 10 winners the French trained runner last ran at Longchamp. All the rest last ran at Royal Ascot. Four ran in the Coronation Stakes (finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>-1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup>). Three others won the Duke of Cambridge Stakes with another 4<sup>th</sup> in that race. The other Royal Ascot runner was 4<sup>th</sup> in the Queen Anne Stakes. Ryan Moore is leading jockey with 3 wins from the last eight races. Irish trained runners have won three of the last six renewals.

**7F HANDICAP (n/a):** New race in 2019 (not run in 2020). Both winners to date had odds of 6/1 and carried 9st 6lbs or less. Both also had a low draw (stalls 1 or 2).

**5F HANDICAP (40%):** Race has been run as both Class 2 and Class 3 handicap. 8/9 winners finished 6<sup>th</sup> or better LTO. All had odds of 9/1 or shorter.

## SATURDAY

**7F MAIDEN FOR 2YO FILLIES (37%):** New race in 2014. Of the eight past winners, five were making their debuts with the others 4<sup>th</sup> or better on their last run. Only two of the eight winners were not either 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourite.

**7F FILLIES HANDICAP FOR 3YO (10%):** Four of the last ten winners had run at Royal Ascot in the Sandringham Stakes (22/23 days earlier) and finished down the field in 12<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> place. Overall, 7/10 past winners carried a weight of 8st 10lbs or greater. All ten winners last ran 11-39 days earlier.

**1M HANDICAP FOR 3YO (20%):** Relatively weak trends for this race. Only four of the ten winners had finished 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> LTO although the last seven winners were all 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on at least one of their last two runs. Three past winners last ran 23 days earlier at Royal Ascot in the Britannia Handicap finishing 17<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> there. R Hannon is the leading trainer with 3 wins since 2013.

**(GR 2) 'SUPERLATIVE STAKES' OVER 7F for 2YO (40%):** None of the last ten winners had finished worse than 5<sup>th</sup> in any of their past races. The Hannon yard & C Appleby have both won 3 times since 2016. Of the last two winners, one was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the English 2000 Gns and the other won the Irish 2000 Gns.

**7F 'BUNBURY CUP' HANDICAP (5%):** Six of the last ten winners last ran at Royal Ascot. Of these three ran in the Royal Hunt Cup 24 days earlier (finishing 20<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>). The others were 1<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> in the Buckingham Palace Handicap and 21<sup>st</sup> in the Wokingham Handicap. In the draw, the hot stall is 14 (7 wins/places in last 10 years) whilst the cold stalls with not even a placed horse in the last ten years are 18 & 7.

**(GR 1) DARLEY 'JULY CUP' over 6F (25%):** It often pays to follow the Royal Ascot form in this race with 6/10 past winners running at the Royal meeting. Of these, the races they ran in plus finishing positions there are detailed as follows: Diamond Jubilee, 2 runners (finished 1<sup>st</sup> & 1<sup>st</sup>). Commonwealth Cup, 3 runners (finished 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>). St James Palace, 1 runner (finished 9<sup>th</sup>).

**1M 4F HANDICAP (40%):** 7/9 past winners were 3<sup>rd</sup> or better LTO. 7/9 winners started as 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> favourites.
